**HOEN AVENUE EMBANKMENT REPAIR PROJECT
PARKING CHANGES**

Residents/Property Owner:

This purpose of this letter is to inform you of some upcoming changes to the existing parking on Hoen Avenue between Brasher Court and Hoen Court. The current long-term parking restrictions that have been in place since March 2017 will become permanent. The decision to implement these changes was made in conjunction with the City Traffic Engineering Division for safety reasons related to protecting the embankment.

The City of Santa Rosa completed a project in October 2020 to stabilize Hoen Avenue between Brasher Court and Hoen Court by utilizing deep polymer injection technology, which was a cost saving pilot project for the City. The roadway within the project limits has been continuously monitored for settlement and although only negligible settlement has been recorded since, it remains to be seen the effects of a normal rainfall season and daily vehicle loadings. There has also been minor bank sloughing near the bottom of Matanzas Creek.

The City is finalizing design plans to reconstruct this section of roadway, shifting both travel lanes away from the creek bank and implementing permanent no-parking restrictions. The City plans to continue monitoring the roadway for settlement. An imminent construction notification letter will be mailed when the schedule has been established.
