MONTGOMERY DRIVE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with Argonaut Constructors for construction of the above referenced project. Construction will begin in late March 2021 and last approximately five to six months.

This project consists of replacing the existing 4" & 6" Water main between Mission Ave. and Jackson Dr. with a single 8" Water main. As part of this project, the City will also be replacing three Fire Hydrants and the existing water services; and relocating the Pressure relief valve to a location that will allow for easier access for maintenance. Two cross drain culverts at Jackson Drive and a section of storm drain located near Mission Blvd will be also be replaced.

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

- Upgraded pipe materials to help improve the water system's performance.
- New water lines to help protect your home and property by improving water flows and pressure to fire hydrants.
- New storm drains to help protect your home and property by improving water flows from storm runnoff.

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project.
