**ADVANCE NOTIFICATION**  
**R7 ROAD ACCESS STABILIZATION REPAIRS PROJECT**  
**YERBA BUENA ROAD & SAINT FRANCIS ROAD**

Dear Resident:

This letter is written to notify you of upcoming construction activities in connection with the subject project. The City of Santa Rosa is finalizing construction plans to improve drainage, rehabilitate an existing access road, and implement slope stability repairs along the access road to City Reservoir 7 (R7), and upgrade the existing storm drain systems in portions of Yerba Buena Road (see reverse for Project Limits). The total project is anticipated to take approximately one year, with the work on Yerba Buena Road taking about 3 months to complete, and an estimated project start date in May 2020.

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

- The upgrading of the existing storm drain system for a portion of Yerba Buena Road.
- Maintaining access to R7, a vital piece of the City's potable water infrastructure.
- Improve slope stability and erosion control with the installation of a retaining wall along a portion of the access road.

As shown, most of the work will take place on the hillside above Yerba Buena Road and St. Francis Road, with the remainder on Yerba Buena Road. Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary

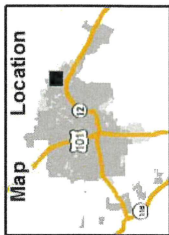
