SEWER MAIN LINING, MANHOLE AND LATERAL REHAB AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS 2016

Dear Residents, Business Owners, Property Managers and School District Employees:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with Insituform Technologies, LLC for construction of the referenced project. Construction will involve rehabilitation of aged manholes in your area. The work will involve cleaning and recoating the interior surfaces of the manhole to extend the effective life of the facility. Rehabilitation of aging sewer systems is of a high priority for the City of Santa Rosa's Capital Improvement Program (CIP). The completion of these CIP projects is vital to the integrity of our infrastructure. Some of the benefits include:

- Improving sewer systems performance by rehabilitating pipe materials and manholes
- Improving sewer systems ability to meet community demands
- Reducing potential for sewer pipe blockages due to tree root intrusion
- Reducing the frequency of sewer maintenance
- Reducing groundwater infiltration into the sewer system, which helps with the effectiveness of our Wastewater Treatment Plant and, in turn, helps to protect our environment

We recognize this construction project will impact traffic and parking in your neighborhood to some degree and at different times throughout the course of construction. Regardless, the contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during construction.

The overall construction will begin approximately in July 2017 and last through November 2017. To the extent this is a multi-site project across the City, the timing for your area will be notified in an update. For your reference, a project map of the site in your area is included on the reverse side of this letter. If you are aware of other occupants on your property who may not receive this notice, please share this notice with them or contact me with their address and I will notify them directly.
