LLANO TRUNK LINING – W. COLLEGE UTILITIES FACILITY

Dear Residents,

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with **SAK CONSTRUCTION, LLC** for construction of the above referenced project. Construction should begin sometime in July 2019 and continue approximately to October 2019. (see reverse for Project Limits).

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits of this project are:

- Rehabilitated sewer pipe and manholes to improve sewer system performance.
- Cured-in place sewer lines reduce the potential for blockages due to tree root intrusion and significantly reduce the need for repairs, and reduce groundwater infiltration into the sewer system which helps maintain the effectiveness of our Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Although temporary impacts to the area are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project.
