ALDERBROOK DRIVE CROSSING TREATMENT

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is finalizing construction plans for a pedestrian median refuge island and two pedestrian curb ramps on opposite sides on 4th Street, adjacent to Alderbrook Drive. The sidewalk, curb & gutter pan on the westside of 4th Street will be replaced with the installation of a curb extension (bulb-out). The project is anticipated to take fifteen (15) working days with an estimated start date of early April 2020. See reverse for project limits.

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Many of the following neighborhood benefits due to this project include:

Enhancing the crossing for pedestrians.

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- Reducing the exposure time experienced by a pedestrian in the intersection.
- Improving the Stopping Sight Distance, for on-coming vehicles travelling westbound on 4th Street, which provides a vehicle driver more room to yield to pedestrians.

Although temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project.
