POST CT AND SIMPSON PL SEWER REPLACEMENTS

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with Terracon Constructors for construction of the above referenced project. Construction will begin in October 2, 2017 and last approximately 4 weeks. The existing sewer main will be replaced in two locations and construction in your neighborhood may not begin on the date listed above, but the contractors will provide you advanced notice. The existing sewer has a known sag in the pipe that creates a low point in the system where solids including fats, oils and grease are captured and results in restricting the flow. Currently the pipes require frequent cleaning, which is breaking down the pipe material. (see reverse for Project Limits).

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

- Upgraded pipe materials to help improve the sewer and water system's performance.
- New sewer lines to (1) reduce the potential for blockages due to tree root intrusion and significantly reduce the need for repairs, and (2) reduce groundwater infiltration into the sewer system, which helps maintain the effectiveness of our Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project. If you have special needs regarding access, or if you have any questions or concerns, please contact the Construction Manager or me at the following numbers:
