Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is hosting a second **Public Meeting on June 21, 2017 from 6pm to 8:30pm at the Rincon Valley Library** to address questions regarding the City's proposed Emergency Groundwater Well at 618 Speers Road.

Thank you for your interest in the project, including emails, phone calls, attending the first informational public meeting on May 3, 2017, and presenting your concerns to City Council on May 6, 2017 and May 22, 2017 regarding the proposed Speers Road location. The following questions/concerns regarding the investigative drilling and possible installation of an emergency well have been brought to our attention and will be addressed at the public meeting:

- Proposed emergency groundwater well's effect on the groundwater table in the Speers Neighborhood and on resident's wells in the surrounding area.
- Analysis of environmental impacts of an emergency groundwater well.
- Notification to residents about the project.
- Emergency well and pump station facilities look and feel in the neighborhood.
- Ability to connect to the City's water and sewer system.
- Impacts to Speers Road due to the potential extension of City water and sewer to the property.
