ROSELAND PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is finalizing construction plans for the above referenced pavement rehabilitation project, which is commonly referred to as overlay. Overlay is a type of street surface repair in which the deteriorated street surface is ground and removed. Once the surface pavement is removed, crews then spread a layer of new hot mix asphalt concrete over the roadway which is rolled and compacted before allowing traffic on the street. All existing striping and/or markings such as "STOP" legends will be reinstated, and most importantly all curb ramps within the project limits will be modified to meet the current ADA standards. The streets selected to receive the overlay treatment were based on the amount of existing roadway surface deterioration. The project is anticipated to take 12 weeks, and it is currently scheduled to start in June 2019 (see reverse for Project Limits).

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

- ADA IMPROVEMENTS
- IMPROVED SKID RESISTANCE
- EXTENDED LIFE OF ROADWAY

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project.
