PAVEMENT PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE 2017 CONTRACT #C02122

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with Argonaut Constructors, Inc. for construction of the above-referenced project. Construction is anticipated to begin in April and last approximately five weeks. These streets were selected from our Citywide Pavement Management Program. Slurry seal is a preventive maintenance application that restores the surface of the roadway and extends the overall life of the pavement. It consists of a thin coat of mixed asphalt emulsion and aggregate. Before slurry is applied, roadway cracks are filled, areas of failed asphalt are repaired, existing striping is removed, and roads are swept clean. (See reverse for Project Limits.)

During this construction period, traffic will be subject to delays. Access to businesses, homes and parking will be temporarily restricted during the placement of slurry. The contractor will provide follow-up notification two weeks and again 72 hours in advance of the construction. The contractor notification will outline the restrictions.
