CITY HALL CAMPUS SIDEWALK RECONSTRUCTION INSTALLATION OF PUBLIC RESTROOM IN DOWNTOWN AREA

Dear Residents/Business Owners:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with FBD Vanguard Construction for construction of <u>CITY</u> <u>HALL CAMPUS SIDEWALK RECONSTRUCTION</u> project. Construction will begin in February 2020 and last approximately 3 months. The City of Santa Rosa is finalizing construction plans to upgrade sidewalk, driveways and curb ramps at the following locations:

- West side of 90 Santa Rosa Avenue
- East side of 635 First Street
- Along D St. in front of Parking Garage

The focus of the project is to improve accessibility along the sidewalk in this area. Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. In addition to the sidewalk reconstruction project, the City of Santa Rosa is installing a 24-hour public restroom along the City owned property frontage at 90 Santa Rosa Avenue. The **INSTALLATION OF PUBLIC RESTROOM IN DOWNTOWN AREA** project will provide a prefabricated single-occupant unisex restroom, called The Portland Loo. The restroom is approximately 6 ft. wide x 9 ft. deep x 9 ft. high, and is designed with durability, safety, security and energy efficiency. Phase 1 will install the utility connections and is expected to start in January 2020 and take approximately one week to complete. Phase 2 will construct The Portland Loo foundation, accessibility, place the restroom and connect the utilities. This final project phase is expected to start in summer 2020 and be completed by fall 2020.
