**BUILDING DEMOLITION-VARIOUS CITY LOCATIONS  
(Juilliard Park)**

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is preparing to demolish the bathroom building at Juilliard Park. The building is being removed because it has out lived its useful life and would cost more to bring it up to current standards, than to build a new building. The building being removed is part of a larger project that will remove unused buildings throughout the City of Santa Rosa. The overall project is anticipated to take 15 weeks, with an estimated start date of June of 2019 ( see reverse for Project Limits).

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood and park are inevitable, our goal is to complete the work without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that weekend work will not be allowed.
