SKYFARM 'A' AND HANSFORD COURT LIFT STATION RECONSTRUCTION

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with Pacific Infrastructure for the construction of the above referenced project with construction scheduled to begin August 2020. This project will undertake the reconstruction of two sewer lift stations that were severely damaged during the Tubbs Fire (see *reverse for project site locations*). The work at these two lift stations will remove all on-site facilities damaged during the fire and replace them with new facilities. This will include new pumps & motors, piping, system controls, emergency backup generator, fencing, lights, new asphalt concrete pavement, and replacement of the building (Skyfarm 'A' only). The Contractor has been directed to work on both sewer lift stations concurrently to minimize construction days and we anticipate project completion Summer 2021.

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

- Repairs and improvements during reconstruction to your local sewer lift station will help improve your neighborhood's sewer system performance and reliability.
- The completed project will reduce the frequency of preventative maintenance and the potential for maintenance repairs at this facility, both of which will result in cost reductions.

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the Construction Manager or me at the following numbers:
