FIRE DAMAGE – RELATED REPAIRS TO THREE PEDESTRIAN BRIDGES / CITY CONTRACT NO. C02229

Dear Resident,

The City of Santa Rosa has awarded the construction contract of the above referenced project to Yukon Construction, Inc. This project will occur at two locations: 1) Parker Hill Road north of Leete Avenue with the installation of new wood decking, to expedite public access to these bridges, repairs will begin at this location first. 2) Francis Nielsen Park pedestrian bridge was damaged beyond repair requiring the design and construction of a new bridge. The new bridge is designed with more fire retardant materials which includes a combination metal girders supporting reinforced concrete decking with a wood railing.

This project is slated to begin in June and finish in September. A slight traffic delay may occur when the work is in progress but will not impact regular trash and mail delivery services. Normal construction hours will be between 8:00 am and 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday.
