## SIX FIRE DAMAGED PARKS RECOVERY – ADVANCE PROJECT NOTIFICATION – CITY CONTRACT NO. C02248

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is finalizing construction plans to restore and repair six City parks and open space parcels located within the Fountaingrove area damaged during the 2017 Tubbs Fire. The project will include restoring landscaping, repairing irrigation and electrical systems, and rebuilding fencing where applicable. Fir Ridge Park will also receive new playground equipment to replace the fire damaged play structures. The project is anticipated to take approximately 24 weeks to complete (weather permitting), with an estimated start date of in October 2021 (see reverse for Project Limits).

The six fire damaged parks and open space parcels in this project are as follows, and are in no particular order:

- Fir Ridge Neighborhood Park
- Frances Nielsen Ranch Park
- Nagasawa Community Park
- Rincon Ridge Neighborhood Park
- Rincon Ridge Open Space
- Parker Hill Trail

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

- ADA accessibility improvement within the closed proximity of the repair zones
- Restoring parks and open spaces for the enjoyment of the community and outdoor recreation.

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project.
