SIX FIRE DAMAGED PARKS RECOVERY - CITY CONTRACT NO. C02248 – IMMENENT CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with OAK GROVE CONSTRUCTION for construction of the above referenced project. Construction will begin May 9, 2022, and last approximately 25 weeks. This project will repair all fire related damaged facilities. The repair areas of impact will be fenced for the duration of the construction and until project acceptance.

Please refer to the location maps on the back side of this notification letter for detail. In order to minimize public inconvenience, the construction approach is to allow the contractor to work on all 6 locations simultaneously. The actual completion of each park depends on the lead time of certain materials from the manufacturers. If this is the case, the majority of park repair work should be completed prior the delivery of long lead time material for installation.

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

- ADA accessibility improvement within the closed proximity of the repair zones.
- Benefit for the community to enjoy the parks and open spaces once again.

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project. 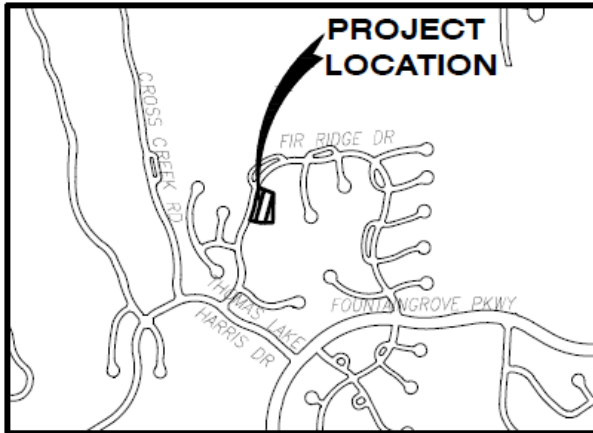

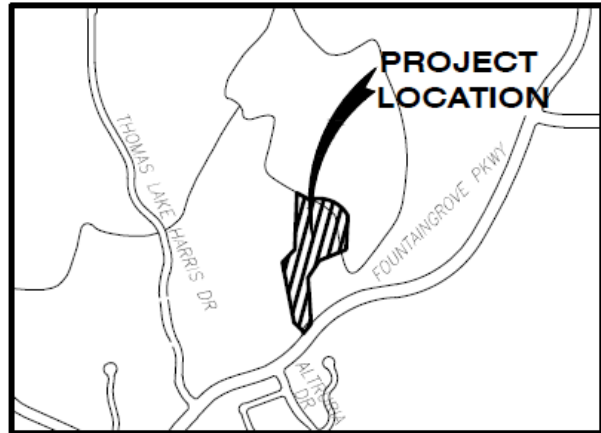

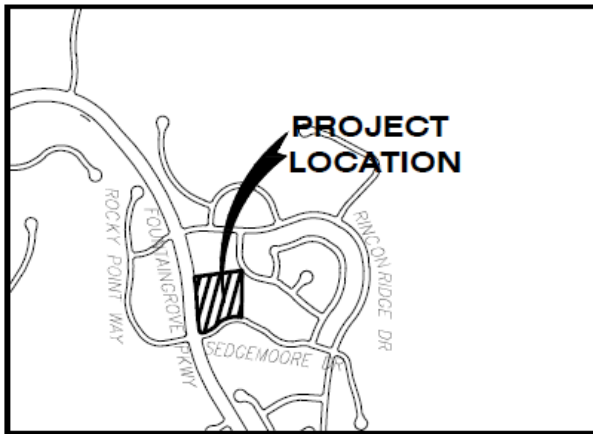
Projection Location Map



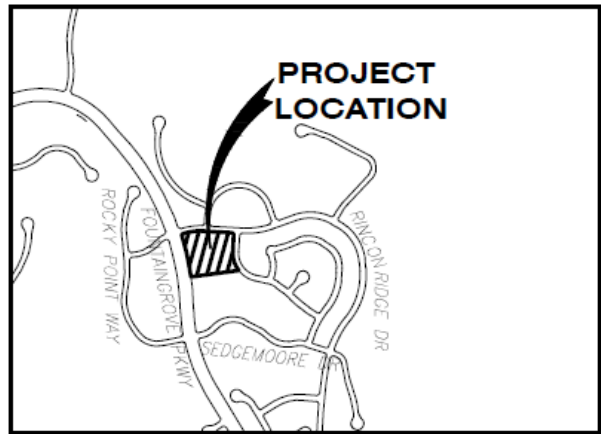
FIR RIDGE PARK



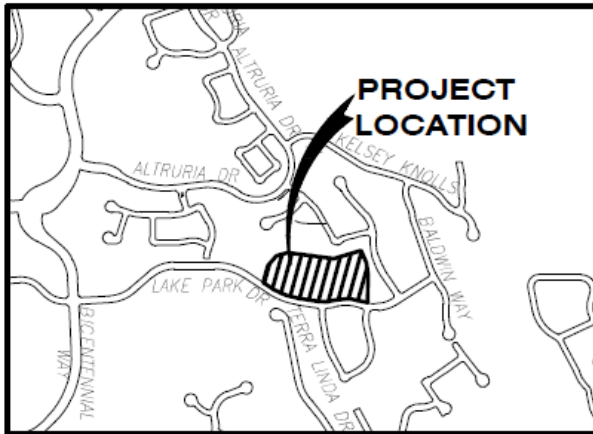
NAGASAWA COMMUNITY PARK



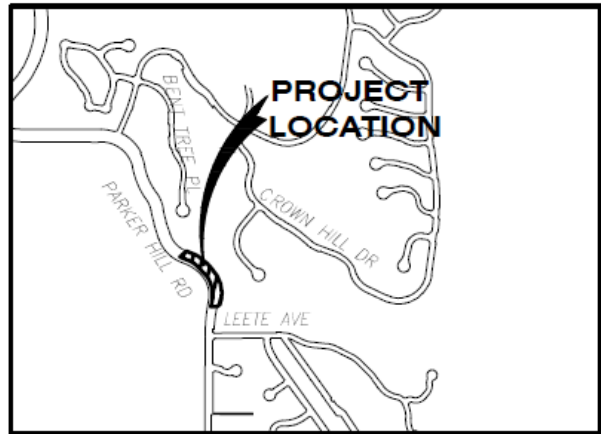
RINCON RIDGE OPEN SPACE
