## STONY POINT RD UTILITY BOX ADJUSTMENTS AND SIDEWALK REPAIRS

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with Yukon Construction, Inc. for construction of the above referenced project. Construction will begin April 2019, and last approximately six weeks. The project intent is to provide sidewalk, to adjust utility boxes installed during the PG&E overhead to underground conversion Rule20A project, and repair gaps in the sidewalk at various locations. (See reverse for Project Limits)

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

 Improving pedestrian access along Stony Point Rd by removing the temporary asphalt patches, adjusting utility boxes to finish grades, and repairing the sidewalks at the box adjustment locations.

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project. Additionally, the Contractor will be advised the driveways are to remain open at all times.
