COFFEY PARK AND FOUNTAINGROVE NEIGHBORHOOD ROAD DISASTER RECOVERY CIP PROJECT NUMBER: C02258

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with Argonaut Constructors for construction of the above referenced project. Construction will begin in November 2023 and last approximately 1.5 years. The project will rehabilitate approximately 33 miles of City residential streets that were damaged as result of debris removal activities in Coffey Park and Fountaingrove neighborhoods following the 2017 Tubbs Fire. The construction is anticipated to approach individual neighborhoods and street segments in series, and because the construction is starting does not mean the impacted street segment(s) will be impacted for the full project duration. Street/sidewalk circulation and parking could be impacted during construction. Notification of street closures, parking restrictions, etc. will be provided in advance of construction impacts. See reverse for Project Limits.

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

- Improve roadway aesthetics by installation of new roadway surface
- Repair damaged sections of roadway which will improve the road drivability
- Extend the service life of roadway to maintain existing infrastructure
- Upgrade pedestrian ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility standards.

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project.
