## **SONOMA AVE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION- FARMERS LN TO HAHMAN DR**

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is finalizing construction plans to rehabilitate the pavement, install sidewalk, upgrade pedestrian ramps, provide striping improvements to include shared bus/bike lanes, bus stop improvements and replace water services on Sonoma Avenue between Farmers Lane and Hahman Drive. The project is anticipated to take 3 months, with an estimated start date in February 2025, weather pending (See reverse for project limits).

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

- Pavement Rehabilitation – Innovative portland cement concrete overlay technology.
- New Sidewalk – Bridge missing sidewalk gaps.
- Striping Improvements – Improve traffic circulation including shared bike/bus lanes
- Bus stop improvements – Relocate westbound bus stop closer to Farmers Lane and install new shelter.
- Pedestrian Ramp Upgrades – Update pedestrian ramps to improve accessibility.
- Water Service Replacement – Replace water services to reduce potential for future excavations.

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project.
