SONOMA AVE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION- FARMERS LN TO HAHMAN DR

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with Ghilotti Bros. for construction of the above-mentioned project. Construction will begin in March 9, 2026 and last approximately 3 months, weather pending. rehabilitate the pavement, install sidewalk, upgrade pedestrian ramps, provide striping improvements to include shared bus/bike lanes, bus stop improvements and replace water services on Sonoma Avenue between Farmers Lane and Hahman Drive. Traffic control will include partial and full closures depending on the work being performed. Transit bus stops will be maintained but relocated as needed (See reverse for project limits).

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

- Pavement Rehabilitation – Innovative portland cement concrete overlay technology.
- New Sidewalk/Pedestrian Ramp Upgrades – Bridge missing gaps and improve accessibility.
- Striping Improvements – Improve traffic circulation
- Bus stop improvements – Relocate westbound bus stop closer to Farmers Lane and install new shelter.
- Water Service Replacement – Replace water services to reduce future excavations.

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project.
