PAVEMENT PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE 2021 CONTRACT #C02357

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with Sierra Nevada Construction, Inc., for the Pavement Preventive Maintenance 2021 construction project. This project will perform road repairs and apply a coat of slurry seal to selected streets in your neighborhood. Construction is anticipated to begin in August 2021 and last approximately 7 weeks. (See reverse for Project Limits)

Slurry seal is a preventive maintenance treatment that restores the surface of the roadway and extends the overall life of the pavement. It consists of a thin coat of mixed asphalt emulsion and aggregate. Before slurry is applied, asphalt repairs are made, roadway cracks are filled, curbside trees are trimmed as needed, existing striping is removed, and roads are swept clean. After slurry has cured, all roads part of the project will be restriped to add buffered bike lanes. In addition to this change, both directions of Summerfield Road between Hoen Avenue and Bethards Drive will be reduced from two lanes to one where it is not already one lane.

During this construction period, traffic will be subject to delays. Access to businesses, homes and parking will be temporarily restricted during the placement of slurry however, the City and our contractor will work to minimize these disruptions. The contractor will provide follow-up notification two weeks prior to construction and again 72 hours in advance of the slurry seal application. The contractor notification will outline the restrictions.
