## **ROSELAND PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE- 2024 / CITY CONTRACT NO. C02383**

## Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with GHILOTTI BROTHERS for the construction of the above-referenced project. Construction will begin in late August and last approximately 8 weeks. This project will start by upgrading all 33 curb ramps to the current Americans with Disability Act (ADA) standards, followed by a two-step process known as the cape seal. A cape seal is comprised of chip sealing followed by a slurry seal and dig-out repairs. All existing striping impacted by the project will be reinstalled to their original configurations.

Though temporary impacts on your neighborhood are inevitable, we aim to improve our community infrastructure without creating more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project.
