RE: TRANSIT MALL ROADBED REHABILITATION CIP PROJECT NUMBER: 02395

Dear Residents & Business Owners:

The City of Santa Rosa is finalizing building plans to rehabilitate the Transit Mall roadbed (see attached for Project Limits). Work on the project is anticipated to restrict access to driveways and parking facilities along the Transit Mall (2<sup>nd</sup> Street). The City will coordinate with residents and businesses that are anticipated to be impacted by the closure and will accommodate the use of driveways exiting onto 2<sup>nd</sup> Street as best we can; however, driveway closures should be expected for the duration of the project. The project duration is estimated at two to three months with an anticipated start date of Fall 2024.

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits this project will provide to the community include:

- Rehabilitate the roadbed to extend its useful and functional life
- Reduction in future service disruptions
- Re-establishment of safe and accessible crossing facilities that meet Americans with Disabilities (ADA) standards

A temporary Transit Mall will be located at 1<sup>st</sup> Street between Santa Rosa Avenue and D Street for the duration of the project.

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will not conduct any activities that generate noise outside of 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday; however, occasional weekend work may be required. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project.

We will update you with another letter approximately two weeks prior to the start of construction. At that time, we will inform you of the Contractor's name and the anticipated work schedule. In addition to written communications like this, the City has created a special website where you can track the progress of this project.
