**HOPPER AVE CORRIDOR FIRE RECOVERY IMPROVEMENTS
PROJECT ID NO. C02406**

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with Argonaut Constructors for construction of the above referenced project. Construction will begin in May 2026 and last approximately 24 weeks. The Hopper Ave Corridor between Coffey Lane and US Hwy 101 south on-ramp will be improved with pavement surface treatments, addition of median islands with trees and vegetation, planter strips with trees and vegetation, bulb outs, and bike and pedestrian facility improvements (see reverse for Project Limits).

Completion of this project is vital to the integrity of our community infrastructure. Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

- Provide a protected bike lane to allow the public to maximize bicycle use for commuting, recreation, and local transport
- Increase pedestrian visibility at crossings
- Improve roadway conditions by narrowing drive lanes to reduce vehicle speeds and improve roadway aesthetics by installation of new roadway surface
- Repair damaged sections of roadway which will improve the road drivability
- Beautify the corridor with landscaping
- Extend the service life of roadway to maintain existing infrastructure
- Upgrade pedestrian ramps to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility standards.

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project. Construction will take place Monday – Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, with staging activities potentially occurring before 8:00 AM.
