**BENNETT VALLEY PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE (SLURRY)  
PROJECT ID NO. C02557**

Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa will be performing the Bennett Valley Pavement Maintenance project from late June through August. The contractor will be applying slurry seal to approximately 14 miles of residential and collector streets in the Bennett Valley area. The City's Transportation and Public Works Department will be preparing the streets before the slurry project starts, assisting with temporary traffic control during the slurry process, and applying pavement striping once the slurry application is complete. A landscaping contractor will be trimming low-hanging tree branches that could be impacted by construction equipment. The project is anticipated to take 5 weeks, with 2 of those weeks for the slurry seal application, with an estimated start date in late July (see reverse for project map).

This project is intended to improve roadway conditions and install new pavement striping. Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

- Repairing damaged sections of roadway to improve overall drivability
- Installing new striping to increase visibility and safety
- Enhancing the appearance of neighborhood streets
- Extending the service life of roadways and preserving existing infrastructure

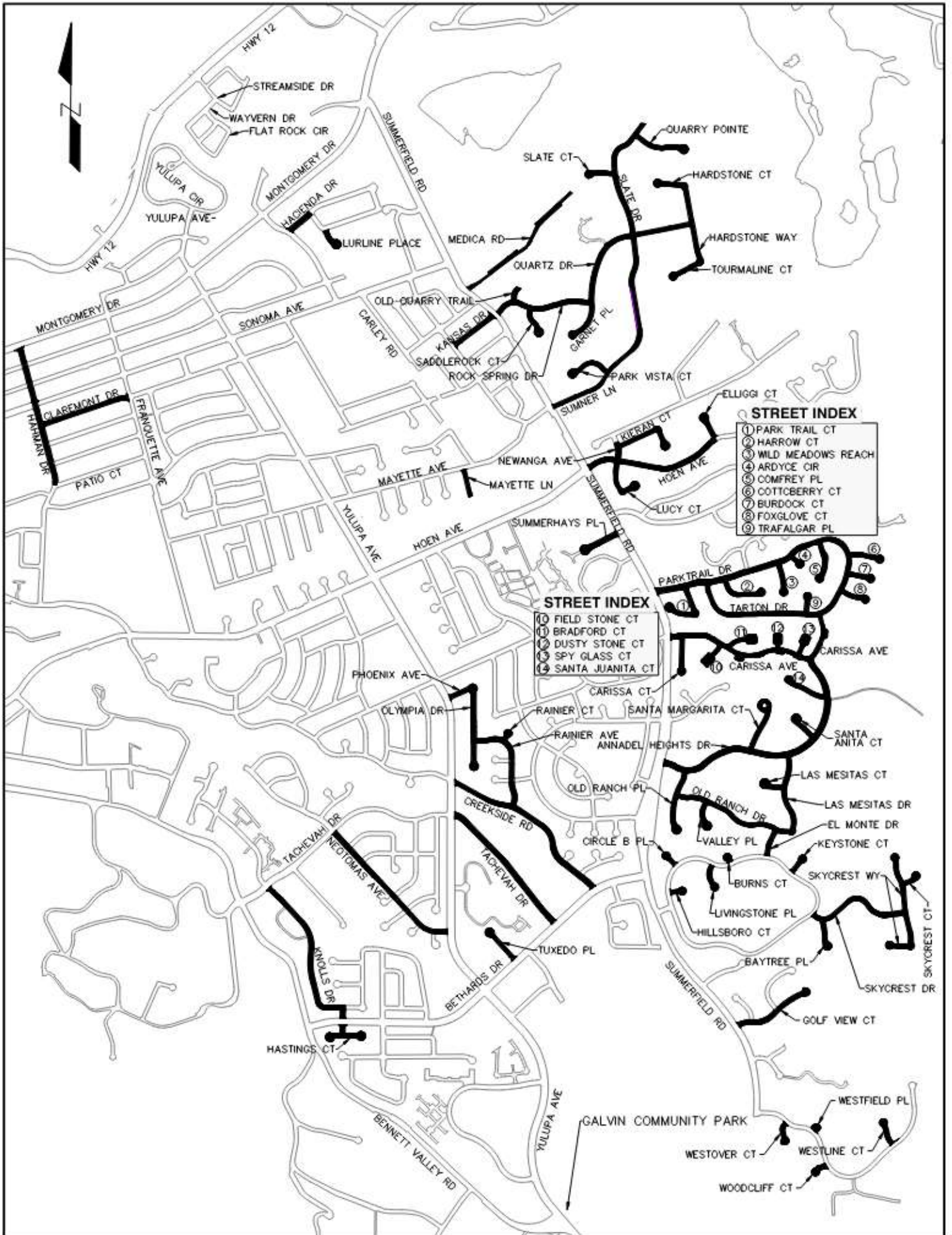
Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project.
