Dear Residents:

The City of Santa Rosa is contracting with Ghilotti Bros., Inc. for construction of the above referenced project. Construction will begin early May and last approximately 18 weeks. This project will consist of constructing a new community garden on an approximately one-acre site located south of the Kawana Springs Road and Amethyst Way intersection (see attachment for Project Limits).

Some of the benefits this project will bring to your neighborhood include:

- New community garden plots with seating area, shade structure, portable restroom, and storage sheds
- A new crosswalk with flashing beacon
- A new sidewalk extending from the garden to Meda Avenue
- Three landscaped planters along Kawana Springs Road

Though temporary impacts to your neighborhood are inevitable, our goal is to improve our community infrastructure without creating any more disturbance than necessary. The Contractor will be advised that daily and weekly activities such as mail delivery and garbage service must continue during the project.
